NOTA INFORMATIVA Nº 76/2013

THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT HAS GRANTED LEAVE FOR A RELIEF APPEAL FILED BY THE PARLIAMENTARY SOCIALIST GROUP AGAINST THE REFORM OF THE JUDICIARY.

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave for an unconstitutionality appeal filed by the Parliamentary Socialist Group of the National Parliament on June 28 of this year against Public General Act 4/2013, June 28, - The Council General of the Judiciary Reform Statute.

The Plenary Meeting has agreed to notify the Congress, the Senate and the Government of this appeal and these institutions have fifteen days in order to become party to these proceedings and lodge any pleadings.

The decision of the Constitutional Court does not entail the suspension of the contested enactment.

The leave to proceed order issued by the Constitutional Court does not entail any judgment on the merits of the case which shall be examined by the Court in the near future.
