NOTA INFORMATIVA Nº 77/2013

THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT HAS GRANTED LEAVE FOR THREE RELIEF APPEALS AGAINST THE POWER SECTOR REFORM.

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave for an unconstitutionality appeal filed by the Parliamentary Socialist Group, by the Parliament of Navarra and by the Regional Government of Navarra against Royal Decree 9/2013, July 12, adopting urgent measures to ensure the financial stability of the power sector.

The Plenary Meeting has agreed to notify the Congress, the Senate and the Government of this appeal and these institutions have fifteen days in order to become party to these proceedings and lodge any pleadings.

The decision of the Constitutional Court does not entail the suspension of the contested enactment.

The leave to proceed order issued by the Constitutional Court does not entail any judgment on the merits of the case which shall be examined by the Court in the near future.

On October 8 last, the Constitutional Court granted leave for an appeal filed against the same Royal Decree Law by the Government of Murcia.
