NOTA INFORMATIVA Nº 80/2013

THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT HAS GRANTED LEAVE FOR AN APPEAL FILED BY THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA AGAINST THE LAW FOR PROTECTION MEASURES APPLICABLE TO PART-TIME EMPLOYEES.

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave for an unconstitutionality appeal filed by the Regional Government of Catalonia against Royal Decree Law 11/2013, August 2, - Law for Protection Measures applicable to part time employee and other urgent economic and labour measures -. It has also granted leave for the appeals filed by the Regional Government of Catalonia against Law 13/2013, August 2 - Law for fostering integration of cooperatives and other association entities in the agrarian and food sector and against Law 12/2003, August 2, on measures for the improvement of the food chain.

The decision of the Constitutional Court does not entail the suspension of the contested enactment.

In the three cases, The Plenary Meeting has agreed to notify the Congress, the Senate and the Government of this appeal and these institutions have fifteen days in order to become party to these proceedings and lodge any pleadings.

The leave to proceed order issued by the Constitutional Court does not entail any judgment on the merits of the case which shall be examined by the Court in the near future.
