## **NOTA INFORMATIVA Nº 81/2013**

### **THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT HAS GRANTED LEAVE FOR AN APPEAL FILED BY THE REGIONAL GOVERNMENT OF EXTREMADURA AGAINST THE LAW OF URGENT MEASURES FOR THE POWER AND FINANCIAL SECTOR.**

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave for an unconstitutionality appeal filed by the Regional Government of Extremadura against Royal Decree Law 2/2013, February 1, on Urgent Measures for the power and financial sector. The decision of the Constitutional Court does not entail the suspension of the contested enactment.

The Plenary Meeting has agreed to notify the Congress, the Senate and the Government of this appeal and these institutions have fifteen days in order to become party to these proceedings and lodge any pleadings.

The leave to proceed order issued by the Constitutional Court does not entail any judgment on the merits of the case which shall be examined by the Court in the near future.
