### **THE SPANISH CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE PSOE'S APPEAL AGAINST THE CLOSURE OF VALENCIA'S PUBLIC TELEVISION**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the appeal brought by the PSOE (Spanish Socialist Group) against Act 4/2013 of 27 November, of the Regional Government of Valencia, on the Discontinuation of Radio and Television Services within the Autonomous Community, owned by the Regional Government, and the Dissolution and Liquidation of Radiotelevisión Valenciana, SAU.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, the Senate and the Government, as well as to the Regional Government of Valencia and the Parliament of Valencia, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
