THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT HAS GRANTED LEAVE TO PROCEED TO SIX APPEALS BROUGHT AGAINST THE ACT FOR IMPROVED QUALITY IN EDUCATION

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality motions filed by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in Congress, the Government and the Parliament of Catalonia and the Governments of Andalusia, Asturias and the Canary Islands, against Public General Act 8/2013, of 9 December, for Improved Quality in Education (LOMCE).

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing claims to the Congress, Senate and the Government, which will have a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeals, which the Court will examine shortly.
