## THE SPANISH CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY THE OMBUDSPERSON AGAINST THE RULE ADJUSTING SPANISH LAW TO EU REGULATIONS IN FINANCIAL ENTITY SUPERVISION MATTERS

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality motion filed by the Ombudsperson against Royal Decree-Law 14/2013, of 29 November, on urgent measures to adjust Spanish law to European Union regulations on the supervision and solvency of financial entities.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the claim to the Congress, Senate and the Government, which will have a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
