THE SPANISH CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEALS LODGED BY THE CATALONIAN GOVERNMENT AND THE COURTS OF ARAGÓN AGAINST THE ENVIRONMENTAL EVALUATION ACT

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality motions filed by the Government of Catalonia and the Courts of Aragón against Environmental Evaluation Act 21/2013, of 9 December.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the claims to the Congress, Senate and the Government, which will have a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
