THE SPANISH CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF ANDALUSIA AGAINST THE ACT TO CONTROL COMMERCIAL DEBT IN THE PUBLIC SECTOR

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality motion filed by the Government of Andalusia against Act 9/2013, of 20 December on the control of commercial debt in the public sector.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the claim to the Congress, Senate and the Government, which will have a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
