THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL LODGED BY THE AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY OF MADRID AGAINST THE URBAN REHABILITATION, REGENERATION AND RENEWAL ACT.

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the Government of the Autonomous Community of Madrid against Act 8/2013, of 26 June, on urban rehabilitation, regeneration and renewal.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress to the Senate, and to the Central Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
