THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO 9 APPEALS BROUGHT AGAINST THE ACT TO APPORTION AND SUSTAIN LOCAL ADMINISTRATIONS

The Plenary Meeting of the TC has granted leave to proceed to 9 unconstitutionality appeals lodged against Act 27/2013 of 27 December, to Apportion and Sustain Local Administrations. The appeals have been lodged by the Governments of the Autonomous Communities of Andalusia, Catalonia and the Canary Islands, by the Government Council of the Principality of Asturias, by the Autonomous Parliaments of Extremadura, Catalonia, Andalusia and Navarra, and by representatives of the Socialist, IU, ICV-EUIA, CHA, La Izquierda Plural, UPyD and Mixto Parliamentary Groups in the Spanish Parliament.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress and to the Senate, and to the Central Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeals, which the Court will examine shortly.
