## **INFORMATION NOTE No. 66/2014**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL LODGED BY THE SOCIALIST PARLIAMENTARY GROUP AGAINST THE REFORM OF THE STATUTE OF CASTILLA-LA MANCHA**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in the Senate against Organic Act 2/2014, of 21 May, of reform of the Statute of Autonomy of Castilla-La Mancha.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, to the Senate, and to the Government, as well as to the Government and Parliament of the Autonomous Community of Castilla-La Mancha, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

In response to the request for the preventive suspension of the application of the Act, lodged by the appellants, the Plenary Meeting decides to request the opinion of all parties, which have been granted a term of fifteen days to report on the matter.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
