## **INFORMATION NOTE No. 85/2014**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE CONFLICT OF COMPETENCE FILED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA AGAINST THE RULE REGULATING ELECTRICITY PRODUCTION**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the positive conflict of competence lodged by the Government of Catalonia against Royal Decree 413/2014, of 6 June, which regulates electricity generation based on renewable energy sources, cogeneration and waste.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the claim to the Government, which has been granted a term of twenty days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit its pleadings.

Furthermore, the Court has resolved to inform the Contentious-Administrative Chamber of the Supreme Court of the filing of this conflict, in case the items covered by this appeal have been or may be challenged. If so, the Supreme Court must suspend the processing of this claim until the TC rules on the conflict of competence.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
