THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL FROM SEVERAL PARLIAMENTARY GROUPS AGAINST THE GRANTING OF EXTRAORDINARY CREDITS IN THE BUDGETS OF THREE MINISTRIES

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the appeal lodged by PSOE, IU and UPyD Parliamentary Groups against Royal-Decree Law 10/2014, of 1 August, which grants extraordinary credits and credit supplements to the budgets of the Ministries of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, Defence and Agriculture, and Food and Environment.

The Court has also resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Parliament, the Senate, as well as the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
