THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE POSITIVE CONFLICT OF COMPETENCE LODGED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA AGAINST THE REGULATION OF PROCEDURES RELATED SCHOOL COST COMPENSATION

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the positive conflict of competence lodged by the Government of Catalonia against Royal Decree 591/2014, of 11 July, regulating the procedures related to entitlement to school cost compensation, foreseen in Public General Act 2/2006, of 3 May, on Education.

The Court has also resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Government, which has been granted a term of twenty days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit pleadings.

The Court will also inform the Contentious-Administrative Chamber of the Supreme Court as well, in case any challenge is underway against this Royal Decree, in which case it will suspend said proceedings until the TC rules on the conflict of competence.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
