THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL LODGED BY THE SOCIALIST GROUP IN THE SENATE AGAINST THE REFORM OF THE ELECTORAL ACT OF CASTILLA-LA MANCHA

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in the Senate against Act 4/2014, of 21 July, which reforms Electoral Act 5/1986, of 23 December, of Castilla-La Mancha.

The Court has also resolved to serve notice of the claim to the Parliament, the Senate, and the Government, as well as to the Parliament and the Government of Castilla-La Mancha, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
