THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE UNCONSTITUTIONALITY APPEAL LODGED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CANARY ISLANDS AGAINST THE ACT ON STATE ACTION AND THE FOREIGN SERVICE

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the Government of the Canary Islands against Act 2/2014, of 25 March, on State Action and the Foreign Service.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, to the Senate, and to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
