## **INFORMATION NOTE No. 14/2015**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO FOUR APPEALS LODGED AGAINST THE ACT ON URGENT MEASURES FOR GROWTH, COMPETITIVENESS AND EFFICIENCY**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeals lodged by the Governments of the Basque Country, Catalonia, Andalusia and the Principality of Asturias against different provisions of Act 2/2014, of 15 October, approving urgent measures for growth, competitiveness and efficiency.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, to the Senate, and to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
