THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO AN UNCONSTITUTIONALITY APPEAL LODGED BY THE SOCIALIST PARLIAMENTARY GROUP AGAINST THE INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ACT

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in Congress against Act 21/2014 of 4 November, amending the consolidated version of the Intellectual Property Act, and against various provisions of Act 36/14, of 26 December on General State Budgets for 2015.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress and to the Senate, as well as to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
