THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO AN APPEAL LODGED BY THE SOCIALIST GROUP IN CONGRESS AGAINST THE VALENCIA ACT ON FISCAL, ADMINISTRATIVE/FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND ORGANIZATIONAL MEASURES

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in Congress against Valencia Act 7/2014, of 22 December, on Fiscal, Administrative/Financial Management and Organizational Measures of the *Generalitat*.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress and to the Senate, as well as to the Government and the Government and Parliament of *Generalitat Valenciana*, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
