THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO AN APPEAL LODGED BY THE CATALONIAN GOVERNMENT AGAINST THE METROLOGY ACT

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Catalanian Government against Metrology Act 32/2014, of 22 December.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress and to the Senate, as well as to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
