## INFORMATION NOTE No. 44/2015

### THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY SEVERAL PARLIAMENTARY GROUPS IN CONGRESS AGAINST THE CITIZEN SECURITY ACT

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by more than fifty congressmen of the Socialist parliamentary group, as well as IU, ICV-EuiA, CHA; Izquierda Plural; Unión Progreso y Democracia; and Grupo Mixto del Congreso de los Diputados, against several precepts of Organic Act 4/2015, of 30 March, on citizen security protection.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, to the Senate and to the Government, as well as to the Government of the Valencian Generalitat and the Valencian Parliament, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to these proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
