A SPECIAL STAMP IS ISSUED TO CELEBRATE THE XXXV ANNIVERSARY OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT

The President of the Spanish Constitutional Court, Francisco Pérez de los Cobos, has officially presented a commemorative postal stamp, printed by the Spanish Postal Service, to celebrate the XXXV Anniversary of the public incorporation of the Court, which took place on 12 July 1980. The act was attended by the Deputy Secretary of the Ministry of Development, Mario Garcés Sanagustín, and the President of the Spanish Postal Service, Javier Cuesta Nuin, amongst other authorities.

The stamp, which began circulating as of today, has a printed picture of the Court's emblematic building. A total of 220,000 units will be printed, with a postal price of 1 €.

During the presentation act, Pérez de los Cobos praised the task performed by the Constitutional Court over its thirty-five year history. He heightened the decisive contribution made by the Court- acting as the "*supreme interpreter*" of the 1978 Constitution- when consolidating Spain's democracy and political diversity, in the recognition and respect for citizens' fundamental rights and the construction of an autonomous state.
