## **INFORMATION NOTE No. 76/2015**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO ANDALUSIA'S APPEAL AGAINST THE REFORM OF THE AUTONOMOUS FINANCING ACT AND THE BUDGETARY STABILITY ACT**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the Government Council of the Autonomous Community of Andalusia against some provisions of Organic Act 6/2015, of 12 June, amending Organic Act 8/1980, of 22 September, on the financing of Autonomous Communities, and Organic Act 2/2012, of 27 April, on Budgetary Stability and Financial Sustainability.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, to the Senate, and to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
