## **INFORMATION NOTE No. 79/2015**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY THE ANDALUSIAN GOVERNMENT AGAINST THE METROLOGY ACT**

The Plenary Meeting of the Spanish Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutional appeal lodged by the Governing Council of Andalusia against several provisions of Metrology Act 32/2014, of 22 December.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress, Senate and Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly; the legal obligation only requires that the appeal meet the formal requirements foreseen by law.
