### **THE TC GRANTS A TEN-DAY TERM TO THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE AND CATALONIAN PARLIAMENT IN ORDER TO REPORT ON CREATING A PARLIAMENTARY COMMISSION TO STUDY THE CONSTITUENT PROCESS**

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has agreed to serve notice to the Public Prosecutor's Office and to the Catalanian Parliament, in order to submit their pleadings, in the incident to enforce a judgment, filed by the Government against the decision adopted by the Catalanian Parliament to create a commission to study the constituent process. The Public Ministry and the Catalanian Parliament have been granted a ten-day term in which to submit their writs.
