## INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 22/2016

### THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO A COMPETENCE CONFLICT FILED BY THE CATALONIAN *GENERALITAT* AGAINST A DECREE REGULATING THE SUPPLY AND GENERATION OF SELF-CONSUMED ELECTRICITY

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (Tribunal Constitucional) has granted leave to proceed to the positive competence conflict filed by the *Catalonian* Government against various provisions of Royal Decree 900/2015, of 9 October, regulating administrative, technical and economic conditions of different forms of supply and generation of self-consumed electricity.

The Court has resolved to forward the claim to the Spanish Government, which will have a term of twenty days in which to provide any documents and pleadings it deems appropriate.

The Plenary Meeting has also decided to notify the filing of the conflict to the Contentious-Administrative Chamber of the Supreme Court, in case said provisions are actually or potentially challenged before the same, in which case “*the ongoing proceedings will be stayed until the conflict is decided*”, as foreseen in Art. 61.2 of the Spanish Public Act of the Constitutional Court [Ley Orgánica del Tribunal Constitucional].

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any pronouncement on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
