THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO GOVERNMENT'S APPEAL AGAINST THE CATALONIAN ACT CREATING THE MUNICIPALITY OF MEDINYÁ

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal lodged by the President of the Spanish Government against Catalanian Act 8/2015, of 10 June, creating the municipality of Medinyá.

The Court has agreed to forward the appeal to Congress, to the Senate and to the Catalanian Parliament and *Generalitat*, which have been granted a fifteen-day term in which to appear as party to the proceedings and present their pleadings.

This leave to proceed does not entail any pronouncement on the merits of the appeal filed, which the Court will settle shortly.
