## **INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 30/2016**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY THE CATALONIAN GOVERNMENT AGAINST THE ROYAL DECREE REGULATING PRIMARY SCHOOL FINAL EVALUATION EXAMS**

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the positive competence conflict filed by the *Catalonian* Government against Royal Decree 1058/2015, of 20 November, regulating the general characteristics of Primary School final evaluation exams, established in Public General Act 2/2006, of 3 May, on Education.

The Court has resolved to forward the claim and documents submitted to the Spanish Government, which will have a term of twenty days in which to provide any documents and pleadings it deems appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any pronouncement on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
