INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 42/2016

THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE COMPETENCE CONFLICT BROUGHT BY THE *GENERALITAT* AGAINST THE ROYAL DECREE REGULATING THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROMOTION PLAN

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the positive competence conflict filed by the Catalanian Government against the allocation of executive duties to state bodies, foreseen in various provisions and in Annex II of Royal Decree 1007/2015, of 6 November, regulating the acquisition by the Carbon Fund for a Sustainable Economy of carbon credits under the Environmental Promotion Plan, in the “*PIMA Empresa*” business sector, to reduce greenhouse gas in its facilities.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Spanish Government, which has been granted a term of twenty days in which to present any documents and pleadings it deems appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the case, which the Court will examine shortly.
