THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE UNCONSTITUTIONALITY APPEALS FILED BY ANDALUSIA AND ARAGÓN AGAINST THE REFORMED HILLS ACT

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeals filed by the Government of Aragón and the Governing Council of Andalusia against Act 21/2015, of 20 July, amending Forestry Act 43/2003, of 21 November.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of both appeals to the Congress of Deputies, to the Senate and to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as parties to each suit and present their pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the case, which the Court will examine shortly.
