INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 57/2016

THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL CONFLICT FILED BY THE CONGRESS AGAINST THE INTERIM GOVERNMENT'S DECISION TO NOT SUBMIT TO PARLIAMENTARY CONTROL INITIATIVES

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the constitutional conflict filed by the Congress of Deputies against the interim Government's decision to not submit to parliamentary control initiatives.

Pursuant to Art. 74 of the Public General Act of the Constitutional Court, the Plenary Meeting has agreed to forward the claim and attached documents to the interim Government, which has been granted a one-month term in which to make the necessary pleadings. This same article also foresees delivery of the claim to the Senate and to the General Council of the Judiciary, in order to be able to appear as party to the proceedings, to support the plaintiff or defendant, if they consider that the solution proposed for the conflict may affect their own attributions.

This leave to proceed does not entail any pronouncement on the merits of the case, which the Court will settle shortly.
