## **INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 59/2016**

### **THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY PODEMOS-EN COMÚ PODEM-EN MAREA AGAINST THE ARAGÓN ACT ON FISCAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE MEASURES**

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the deputies of the Parliamentary Group Podemos-En Comú Podem-En Marea against Act 2/2016, of 28 January, on fiscal and administrative measures of the Autonomous Community of Aragón, due to the amendments it makes to Aragón Act 10/2014, of 27 November, on water sources and rivers.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the claim to the Congress of Deputies, the Senate and the Government, as well as the General Deputation of Aragón and the Parliament of Aragón, which will have a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit any pleadings.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the case, which the Court will examine shortly.
