THE TC GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO PODEMOS's APPEAL AGAINST THE REFORM OF THE TOURISM ARRANGEMENT ACT OF THE CANARY ISLANDS

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court (TC) has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Parliamentary Group Unidos Podemos-En Comú Podem-En Marea against various provisions of Act 2/2016, of 27 September, amending Act 6/2002, of 12 June, on territorial arrangement measures for tourism in the Islands of El Hierro, La Gomera and La Palma.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the foregoing appeal to the Congress of Deputies and to the Senate, as well as to the Parliament and Government of the Canary Islands, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the suit and present any pleadings deemed appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed, and the interim suspension, do not entail any decision whatsoever on the merits of the appeals, which the Court will examine shortly.
