## **INFORMATIVE NOTE No. 27/2017**

### **THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE GOVERNMENT'S APPEAL AGAINST THE EXTREMADURA ACT ON EXTRAORDINARY MEASURES TO FIGHT SOCIAL EXCLUSION**

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the President of the Government against several provisions of Extremadura Act 7/2016, of 21 July, on extraordinary measures to fight social exclusion.

The Court has agreed to forward the appeal to the Congress of Deputies and to the Senate, and to the Regional Government of Extremadura and the autonomous Assembly, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit any pleadings deemed appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any prejudgment on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
