THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE UNCONSTITUTIONALITY APPEAL BROUGHT BY PSOE AGAINST THE BUDGET OF THE CATALONIAN *GENERALITAT* FOR 2017

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Socialist Parliamentary Group in the Congress of Deputies against additional provision 40 of Act 4/2017, of 28 March, on Budgets of the Catalanian *Generalitat* for 2017.

The Court has agreed to forward the appeal to the Congress of Deputies, to the Senate and to the Government, as well as to the *Generalitat* and Catalanian Parliament, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit any pleadings deemed appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any prejudgment on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
