THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY PODEMOS AGAINST MEASURES TO PROTECT CONSUMERS AFFECTED BY “FLOOR CLAUSES”, PASSED BY THE GOVERNMENT

The Plenary Meeting of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality appeal brought by the Confederate Parliamentary Group “Unidos Podemos-En Comú Podem-En Marea” against Royal Decree-Law 1/2017, of 20 January, on urgent measures to protect consumers against “floor clauses”.

The Court has agreed to forward the appeal to the Congress of Deputies, to the Senate and to the Government, which have been granted a term of fifteen days in which to appear as party to the proceedings and submit any pleadings deemed appropriate.

The granting of leave to proceed does not entail any prejudgment on the merits of the appeal, which the Court will examine shortly.
