THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT ADMITS THE APPEALS LODGED BY THE OMBUDSMAN AND PODEMOS AGAINST THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE FORESTRY LAW OF THE PRINCIPALITY OF ASTURIAS

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has admitted the appeals on the grounds of unconstitutionality lodged by the Ombudsman and the Unidos Podemos/En Comú Podem/En Marea Confederated Parliamentary Group against Principality of Asturias Law 2/2017, of 24 March, enforcing the second amendment to Principality of Asturias Law 3/2004, of 23 November, on Forestry and Forest Management.

The Court has resolved to serve notice of the appeal to the Chamber of Deputies and to the Senate, along with the Autonomous Government and Parliament of the Principality of Asturias, which are afforded fifteen days in which to appear as a party to the proceedings and make any representations they deem appropriate.

Admission does not represent any form of advance decision on the merits of the appeals, which the Court will resolve shortly.
