THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE CONFLICT OF COMPETENCE BROUGHT BY THE CANARY ISLANDS AGAINST THE ROYAL DECREE ESTABLISHING THE LEGAL REGIME ON INTERNAL CONTROL OF LOCAL PUBLIC BODIES

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the positive conflict of competence lodged by the Government of the Canary Islands against the national Government with respect to Article 1.2 of Royal Decree 424/2017, dated April 28th, which regulates the legal regime of internal control concerning entities of the Local Public Sector.

The Court resolved to communicate the application to the national Government, which will have twenty days to submit the arguments and documents it deems appropriate.

The admission of the appeal does not imply any ruling by anticipation on the substance of the appeal, which will be decided by the Court at a later date.
