THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE CONFLICT OF COMPETENCE BROUGHT BY THE GOVERNMENT OF CATALONIA AGAINST THE LAW THAT REGULATES THE SYSTEM OF EMPLOYMENT AND PROFESSIONAL TRAINING IN THE WORK ENVIRONMENT

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the conflict of competence brought by the Government of Catalonia against various provisions of Royal Decree 694/2017, dated July 3rd. This Decree implements Law 30/2015, dated September 9th, which regulates the System of Employment and Professional Formation in the work environment.

The Court resolved to communicate the application to the Government, which will have 20 days to submit the documentation and arguments it deems appropriate.

The admission of the appeal and issuing a precautionary suspension do not imply any ruling by anticipation on the substance of the appeal, which will be decided by the Court at a later date.
