THE COURT GRANTS LEAVE TO PROCEED TO THE ACTION OF UNCONSTITUTIONALITY BROUGHT BY UNIDOS PODEMOS AGAINST THE LAW ON PUBLIC PROCUREMENT

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court of Spain has granted leave to proceed to the unconstitutionality action brought by the Parliamentary Group Unidos Podemos-En Comú Podem-En Marea in the Congress of Deputies against several provisions of Act 9/2017, dated November 8th, on Public Procurement, whereby Directives 2014/23/EU and 2014/24/EU, dated February 26th 2014, are transposed to the Spanish legal system.

The Court has decided to transmit the appeal to the Congress of Deputies, the Senate and the Government, which all have now a period of fifteen days in order to join as parties in the proceedings and submit their arguments.

Granting leave to proceed do not imply any ruling by anticipation on the substance of the appeal, which will be decided by the Court at the end of the proceedings.
