THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT DISMISSES, WITH THE VOTE OF A MAJORITY OF MEMBERS, THE ACTION OF UNCONSTITUTIONALITY AGAINST THE LAW ON EDUCATION BROUGHT BY THE SOCIALIST GROUP

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has, by a majority of eight votes, resolved to dismiss the action of unconstitutionality brought by the Socialist Parliamentary Group of the Congress of Deputies against Organic Law 8/2013, dated December 9th, on the improvement of the quality of education.

The Judgement, for which Magistrate Alfredo Montoya has acted as rapporteur, contains the following operative part:

- “1. Rejection of the request to join the proceedings made by the Parliament of Navarre.*
- 2. Dismissal of the action of unconstitutionality lodged by more than fifty Deputies of the Socialist Parliamentary Group of the Congress of Deputies”.*

The ruling is accompanied by the concurring opinion of the Vice-President of the Court, Encarnación Roca, whereas Magistrates Fernando Valdés Dal-Ré, Juan Antonio Xiol, Cándido Conde-Pumpido and María Luisa Balaguer have announced a dissenting opinion.
