THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT WILL EXAMINE THE *AMPARO* APPEAL BROUGHT BY *CIUDADANOS* AGAINST SEVERAL RESOLUTIONS OF THE BUREAU OF THE PARLIAMENT OF CATALONIA, WHICH ALLOWED A PARLIAMENTARY MOTION THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY ANNULLED BY THIS COURT

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court (TC) has unanimously resolved to grant leave to proceed to the appeal filed by MPs of the parliamentary group *Ciudadanos* of Catalonia against several Resolutions of the Bureau of the Parliament which processed a parliamentary motion that was annulled by this Court.

The Plenary considers that this application fulfils the “special constitutional relevance” requirement to review it, since the issue brought is transcends this particular case and might have general political consequences.

In their appeal, the plaintiffs consider that their right to political participation may have been violated (article 23 of the Spanish Constitution).

The Constitutional Court has now requested to the Parliament of Catalonia to provide a certified copy of the measures taken in relation to the Resolutions of the Parliamentary Bureau whose regulation was declared unconstitutional and invalid.
