THE PLENARY OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT WILL EXAMINE THE APPEAL OF UNCONSTITUTIONALITY BROUGHT BY THE CENTRAL GOVERNMENT AGAINST NAVARRESE LAW 14/2018 ON WASTE AND ITS TAX REGIME

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the appeal of unconstitutionality (*“recurso de inconstitucionalidad”*) brought by the President of the central Government. This appeal challenged art. 23 paragraph 1 a) and 2 of the Navarrese Law 14/2018 (*“ley foral”*) dated 18 June on waste and its tax regime.

The Court has resolved to notify the content of the judicial proceedings to the Congress of Deputies, to the central Government as well as to the executive and parliamentary bodies of the Region of Navarre so that they may join the proceedings as parties and submit the arguments they deem appropriate.

Without requesting the suspension of the contested article, the Government argues that there might be a violation of State exclusive competences jurisdiction in matters of general planning of the economic activities (Article 149.1.13 of the Spanish Constitution).
