THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT WILL EXAMINE THE APPEAL BROUGHT BY MORE THAN 50 *PARTIDO POPULAR* MPs AGAINST LAW 13/2018, ON WALKING AND HIKING TRAILS OF MALLORCA AND MENORCA

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has resolved to grant leave to proceed to the appeal of unconstitutionality ("*recurso de inconstitucionalidad*") lodged by more than 50 MPs of the *Partido Popular* Parliamentary Group at the Congress of Deputies. The appeal was brought against articles 50.1 and 50.2 of Law 13/2018 of the Balearic Islands, dated 28 December, on public walking and hiking trails of Mallorca and Menorca.

The Court ordered to notify the appeal and all related documents to the Congress of Deputies, to the Senate and to the Parliament and the Government of the Balearic Islands so that they can make the submissions they deem appropriate.

In their appeal, the MPs considered that the challenged law violates article 33 of the Spanish Constitution.
