## **PRESS RELEASE No. 95/2019**

### **THE PLENARY OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT WILL EXAMINE THE APPEAL OF UNCONSTITUTIONALITY FILED BY THE OMBUDSMAN AGAINST THE REGIONAL HUNTING LAW OF CASTILLA Y LEÓN**

The Plenary Session of the Constitutional Court has granted leave to proceed to the appeal of unconstitutionality filed by the Spanish Ombudsman against paragraphs 1, 3, 5 and 6 of the single article; and against the transitory provision of Law 9/2019, dated March 29<sup>th</sup>, of Castilla y León, which modifies Law 4/1996, dated July 12<sup>th</sup>, on Hunting.

The Court has ordered to notify the appeal and all related documents to the Congress of Deputies, to the Senate, to the Government, as well as to the Parliament and the Government of Castilla y León, so that they may join the proceedings as parties and make the submissions they deem appropriate.

The Ombudsman considers that the challenged provisions may violate articles 9.3, 24.1, 45.1, 45.2, 45.3 and 149.1.23 of the Spanish Constitution.
