**THE PLENARY OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT ACCEPTS THE
APPEALS FOR UNCONSTITUTIONALITY FILED BY THE GOVERNMENT
OF THE GENERALITAT AND THE PARLIAMENT OF CATALONIA
AGAINST THE DECREE-LAW 14/2019, ON URGENT MEASURES IN
DIGITAL ADMINISTRATION**

The Plenary of the Constitutional Court has accepted two appeals for unconstitutionality filed by the Government of the Generalitat of Catalonia and the Parliament of Catalonia, respectively. These appeals are lodged against several articles and the single additional provision and, in connection with it, the first and second transitional provisions and the final provision of the Royal Decree-Law 14/2019, of 31 October, on the adoption of urgent measures regarding digital administration, contracts in the public sector and telecommunications.

The Court has agreed to notify the appeal and the documents filed to the Congress of Deputies, the Senate and the Government so that they may enter their appearance in the proceedings and present their allegations.
