**THE PLENARY OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL COURT UNANIMOUSLY
ACCEPTS THE APPEALS OF UNCONSTITUTIONALITY FILED BY
PARLIAMENTARY GROUPS PP AND VOX AGAINST THE SECOND FINAL
PROVISION OF ROYAL DECREE 8/2020 APPROVING THE
INCORPORATION OF THE GOVERNMENT'S VICE-PRESIDENT PABLO
IGLESIAS AS PART OF THE DELEGATE COMMISSION OF THE
NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE CENTRE**

The Plenary of the Constitutional Court has unanimously accepted the appeals of unconstitutionality filed by over 50 senators from the parliamentary group Popular Party (PP) and over 50 deputies from the parliamentary group VOX against the second final provision of Royal Decree-Law 8/2020, of 17 March, on the adoption of extraordinary urgent measures to deal with the social and economic impact of Covid-19.

The Court has ordered to notify the appeal and its appended documents to the Congress of Deputies, the Senate and the Government, so that they may enter their appearance in these proceedings and file the arguments they deem appropriate.

The appellant groups consider that the challenged rule may have infringed articles 86.1 and 9.3 of the Spanish Constitution.
